KEILOR PARK JUNIOR SOCCER TOURNAMENT 2010 CUP RULES

DURATION OF MATCHES

For Round Robin Matches, the duration will be as follows:

For Semi Finals and Final Matches, the duration will be as follows:

First Team in the fixture draw is to supply Match Balls.

All Teams to provide linesman for all Round Robin and Finals Matches.

TIME AND SCORE

No extra time during Round Robin matches.

Scoring during Round Robin matches, will be as follows:

- 3 points for Win*
- 1 point for Draw*
- 0 point for Losing*
- 3 points and 3 goals, Against Teams that Forfeits Matches.*

If Teams finish on equal points during Round Robin matches, or should these be equal, the Winner shall be decided as follows:

- The Team with greater number of goal differences, or should these be equal,*
- The Team with greater number of goals scored, or should these be equal,*
- Penalty Kicks will take place, as per FFV rules.*

For Semi Finals and Final matches, the results will be determined as follows:

- Extra time of 2 x 5 minute halves, sudden death elimination (Golden Goal) shall apply ie first Goal scored in extra time Wins the match.*
- If result still a Tie after extra time, the match will be decided on Penalty Kicks, as per FFV rules.*

SPECIAL CONSIDERATION RULE

*In the event that an age group has a group with a lesser number of teams in one group the teams in the lesser group score will be multiplied by 1.5 so as not to disadvantage that group for playing one less game. This will also include multiplying the goals for and goals against by 1.5
This rule will only apply to teams in groups where one group has fewer competitors than the other two groups.*

TEAMS / TEAM LIST & TEAM SHEET

Sub-Junior & Junior (Number of Players):

- Under 9's teams are permitted to register a maximum squad of 12 (twelve) players, with a maximum of 7 (seven) players on the field (6 field players and goalkeeper) at any time.
- Under 11's teams are permitted to register a maximum squad of 14 (fourteen) players, with a maximum of 9 (nine) players on the field (8 field players and goalkeeper) at any time.
- All Teams from Under 12's and over are permitted to register a maximum squad of 17 (seventeen) players with a maximum of 11 (eleven) players on the field (10 field players and goalkeeper) at any time.

Where there is a grouping of 4 teams or more with multiple groupings a 1st and 2nd Semi Final process of elimination matches will determine the finals match

Where there is a grouping of 3 teams or more with multiple groupings a single Semi Final process of elimination matches will determine the finals match

A player can only play for one team and one age group throughout the Tournament, including Semi Finals and Final matches.

All players must wear the designated number given to him / her as per the tournament team sheet for the duration of the tournament

All players are required to wear the same numbered top during all matches

All Teams must provide the Tournament, Co-ordinator with a Team List prior to the commencement of the Competition, one registration form per team for all matches (refer to attached copy).

Clubs may only enter teams into the competition provided that the said team participated in the FFV home and away fixture for this season.

Clubs can invite 3 Guest players to participate in the Tournament; however it is the responsibility of each club to provide proof of age for Guest players. These players must be registered with the FFV for the current season in order to allow them to play during the carnival.

In the event that a club has more than one team in an age group and those teams play each other it is the responsibility of that club to supply an alternative playing strip for one of those teams.
It is recommended that each team carry with them a set of coloured training bibs

On the completion of each match each team must leave the ground immediately so to allow the following teams access to the ground.

It is the responsibility of each team to be ready and on the playing pitch at the designated time. Failing to do so may result in the match official and/or referee shortening the match so to keep all games on schedule.

All clubs must provide the following proof of their player's age upon request by the tournament co-ordinator:

*FFV Endorsed id card
FFV Endorsed Team List
Team List endorsed by the Club Secretary
Copy of player's birth certificate or any other proof of age*

Clubs who have more than one Team entered in the same age group must nominate their players for each team prior to the commencement of the competition.

All Teams are to provide lines person during the Round Robin matches and to report to the Referee prior to the commencement of each match.

The tournament co-ordinator reserves the right to refuse entry to any team.

CROWD CONTROL

All Teams are responsible for their own supporter's behaviour.

Coaches, Team Managers and interchange players must remain in the Coaches Box during the match.

Any incident involving any misconduct will be referred to the Carnival Co-ordinator, who will investigate the matter and his/her decision will be final.

Any abuse to the person officiating the match will not be tolerated. Any teams who breach this may be dismissed from the tournament.

DISCIPLINE

All decisions made by the match official and/or referee during the course of the match shall be binding and final.

Any or all disputes will only be discussed with the Coach and/or Team manager of the teams that are in dispute.

If any player is sent off by the match official and/or referee, he will automatically receive one match suspension.

If player receives two (2) yellow cards during the same match, he will miss the next match.

If player receives three (3) yellow cards during the carnival matches, he will automatically miss the next match.

For any of the above cases, the Tournament Co-ordinator will notify the relevant player's Team Manager as to when the player will be eligible to resume playing.

If the match official and/or referee sends off any Club Officials or reports any Club's disputes, the matter will be investigated by the Tournament Co-ordinator, who will take the appropriate disciplinary action if necessary, which may warrant disqualification from the match/s or the Carnival. Any decision made will be final and binding on all Clubs concern.

If any club plays an over age player, the Team in concern will be automatically disqualified from the Tournament and further disciplinary action may be taken against the Club ie. Banning the club from future tournaments.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS

Due to health and safety regulations it is a condition of entry / participation / registration for the tournament that no outdoor cooking, barbeque to be held during the tournament period.

SPONSORS

Access/entry to the tournament is for official tournament sponsors only.

SMALL SIDED FOOTBALL (SSF) U9-U11

To restart play after a save or gathering the ball with their hands, the goalkeeper is not permitted to kick the ball directly from their hands. The ball must be thrown or rolled from the hands or rolled from the hands or played from the ground with their feet.
